**Parent Information for 2004 Girl Scout Cookie Program**

**What are the procedures?**

Brownie, Junior, Cadette and Senior Girl Scout troops are expected to participate in this most important cookie program.

Troops are responsible for all cookies they order. Once cookies are issued to a girl, she and her parents/guardians are responsible for all cookies and money. **COOKIES MAY NOT BE RETURNED!** Checks are not acceptable. **CASH ONLY!**

Girls should sell in uniform or wear a Girl Scout pin. Only registered members and their parents may sell cookies. All girls should have proper adult supervision when selling.

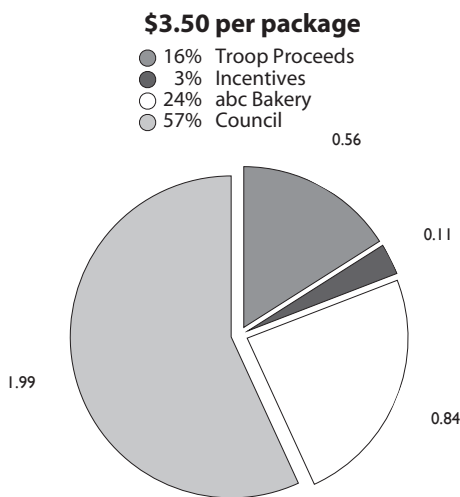
**Did you know?**
