Requirements: Complete 7 activities including the 3 starred requirements.

1. *Talk to other leaders in your service unit or talk to your service unit director for help in finding a sister troop. Sister troops can be from your own service unit or another service unit in your area and may be from a different Girl Scout level. Leaders can contact each other and agree to be sister troops.
2. *Meet together a Minimum of 3 times during the Girl Scout year. Each troop should initiate one meeting and plan activities for the meeting. The third Meeting should be jointly planned by both troops.
3. *Write letters, draw pictures, and/or take photos to tell your sister troop about you. Send them or take them to your sister troop before your first meeting together.
4. Plan and do a joint service project with your sister troop
5. Make a craft or art-to-wear project to share with your sister troop.
6. Plan a Special holiday celebration (Girl Scout holiday or traditional holiday) with your sister troop For example, have a Valentine or May Day party where you can make valentines or May baskets for each other or as a service project and give them to the elderly, decorate a Christmas tree or go caroling together, have a special Girl Scout birthday celebration etc.
7. Go on a camping trip, picnic, or other Outdoor adventure with your sister troop. Older girls can teach younger girls a new Outdoor skill. Learn to enjoy nature together.
8. Teach your sister troop a favorite song or game.
9. Share with your sister troop what the Girl Scout Promise and Girl Scout Law mean to you. You can write it down and send your ideas to your sister troop or you can discuss your answers at a joint meeting
10. Help your sister troop work on a try-it, badge, or interest project. Junior troops may choose to compete the Junior Aide patch if their sister troop is a bridging Brownie troop.
11. Go on a field trip or attend a service unit event or council sponsored event with your sister troop.
12. If your sister troop is bridging, help them work on their bridging steps. Bridging troops may also want to ask their sister troop to participate in their bridging ceremony
